

How will my child progress?

Early years provision is of a high standard. Pupils are given daily opportunities to be creative and to practise a range of art skills as well as developing their fine motor skills with a range of other activities which are assessed against the EYFS goals.

Through KS1 and KS2, our skills progression is used to plan effectively. We have an ambitious curriculum in terms of expectations for skills development and exposure to a range of media. Pupils use sketchbooks to plan and prepare their final pieces. Year 6 pupils have reported that their preparations helped them to make significant progress and to see the journey they have been on. Their final pieces are then displayed in their books (either originals or photographs) with many pieces exhibited around school. Pupils' progress is evident throughout their books which they carry through school.

Each year, teachers assess pupils' progress and record their attainment, identifying the pupils working above and below age related expectations, offering further support accordingly.
