For example, the launch of our Pitmaston Culture Vultures project, invites pupils and their families to visit local sites of interest with rewards in school. These sites were chosen to highlight to parents and carers the breadth of local activities available.

We regularly invite visiting artists to hold workshops with pupils giving them the opportunity to meet professional artists, to aspire to a life in art and to create some excellent artwork and valuable memories.
