 Using different ways of moving safely
 Good pencil control
 Mark making and drawing
 Using cutlery

Summer - Ball games
 Throw, kick and catch a large ball

Literacy

Autumn: RWI set 1 sounds

- Name writing
- Orally segment single sound CVC words
- Initial sounds in words
- Write some initial sounds

Spring: Simple phrases

- Link sounds to letters
- Write CVC words
- Writing labels
- Simple captions
- Simple sentences

Summer: Traditional Tales

- Tripod grip and accurate letter formation
- Write some tricky words
- Write simple sentences and read them back

 Exploring art resources

 Talk about artwork
 Use props to retell stories

Safely use tools
 Design art
 Role play familiar stories
 Perform songs

Understanding the World

Autumn: A Celebration of Culture

Talk about changes
 Talk about family
 Becoming aware of the past
 Talk about pictures of the past
 Be positive about difference

Spring: Talking about events in detail e.g. holidays and special places

Talking about the differences between the past and now
 Talking about stories and picture books
 Explore the natural world

Summer: Talking about lives of people

Talk about the roles of people in society
 I can talk about the past using books and events
 Discuss differences between different cultures and countries

Mathematics

Autumn:

Numbers to 10 - matching quantity and counting
 Subitise to 3
 Compare quantities
 Follow simple patterns
 Count to 10
 Understand how numbers are made up e.g. 4 = 3+1

Spring:

Count objects, claps and movements to 10
 Match numerals to quantity to 10
 Subitise to 5 and recall number bonds
 Count to 20
 Begin to recognise odd and even numbers linked to sharing

Summer:

Numbers to 10 - part, part whole models
 Recognise numbers to 10
 Recall number bonds to 5 and 10
 Count beyond 20
 Compare quantities
 Say double facts
 Share equally
