

Cyber Buddy News

The class cyber buddies have written this newsletter to let you know what each year group has been learning in e-safety this half term.

Year 6 have been learning about Cyberbullying. We learnt that Cyberbullying is increasing as more children have their own phones and tablets. Cyberbullying can happen at any time so it is important that we know how to keep ourselves safe when using our own online devices. We looked at what we could do if we thought we were being cyberbullied and how we could help a friend if we thought it was happening to them.

In Year 3 we have been learning about creating online surveys. We looked at the ethical and legal requirements of creating a website. We learnt that most websites are designed to make you want to buy something or to provide you with information.



In Year 2 we looked at how to send emails safely we learnt:

- If you receive an email from someone you don't know, tell an adult
- Check the email address you are sending to is correct
- Always be polite in your email
- Don't open an email from someone you don't know
- Don't click on links or attachments
