Reception

History skills covered in EYFS include looking at similarities, differences and changes occurring over time, in Understanding the World strand of the Early Years Curriculum. This example of a Winter Walk Tapestry Observation:

This morning we looked at some photographs of Winter, then went for a winter walk. We had identified different things we would look out for such as a robin, holly and an Evergreen tree. The children were curious about the frost on the ground and spent lots of time exploring the outdoor environment. They noticed trees that were similar but also noticed the change that winter brings as a lot of our trees were bare. The children looked and listened for birds but also noticed the other sounds they could hear. When we returned to the classroom the children ticked all the different things they had seen on their sheet. They then drew and painted winter pictures.
