I'm Sarah Hayes. I'm a Teaching Assistant at Pitmaston Primary School. I'm also a scriptwriter (MPhil, University of Birmingham).

Does your child love coming up with stories? Would they like to turn those stories into live action? I'm offering the opportunity for children in **Years 4, 5 and 6** to join me for a

6-week block of scriptwriting workshops. Children will be learning the craft at a high level - covering character development, plot, dialogue and the differences between writing for stage, screen and radio.

At the end of the 6 weeks, grown-ups will be invited to see a short rehearsed reading of the plays - no need for costumes or to learn lines! Each child will be presented with a bound copy of their script with their worksheets and a certificate of completion.

In order to give each child individual focus and develop their ideas, **spaces are very limited.**

The workshops will run in school on **Thursdays, 3.25pm - 4.25pm** from Thursday 17th September to Thursday 22nd October.

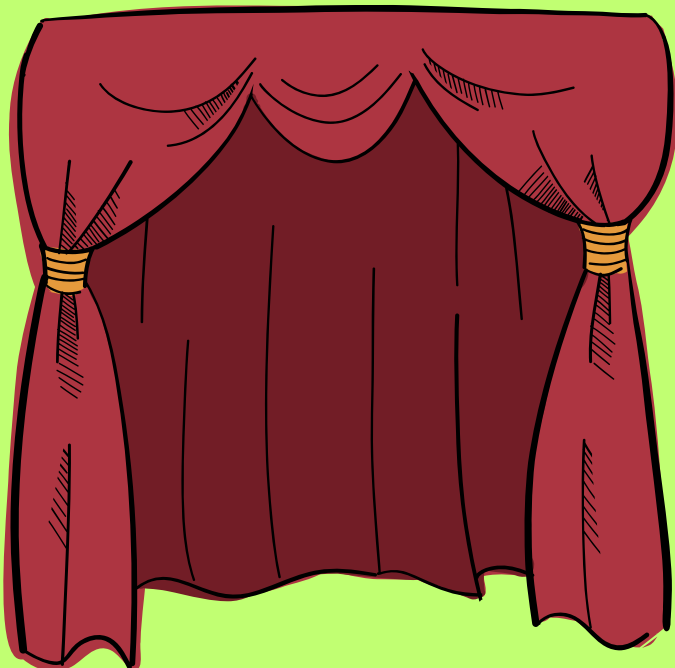
